



**The South African National Accreditation Systems (SANAS), based in Pretoria, is listed as a Schedule 3A public entity according to the National Public Entities classification. SANAS is mandated to be the sole provider of national accreditation services, whereby it formally recognises the technical competency of calibration and conformity assessment service providers that offer testing, inspection, verification and calibration services as well as inspection against OECD GLP principles in both the public and private domains.**

### **INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME 2017/18**

**Duration: From 01 September 2017 to 31 August 2018**

The South African National Accreditation System (SANAS) offers Internship opportunities to South African graduates who wish to apply for the SANAS Internship Programme.

Candidates from the following fields of study are invited to apply:

- Any technical field, eg. Engineering (Chemical, Mechanical, Electrical), Chemistry, Medical Science, Agricultural Science & Veterinary, etc.

#### **Requirements**

- Applicants must be South African citizens with a valid South African ID Number;
- Applicants must not have been previously employed;
- Applicants must not have been previously employed under any Internship Programme;
- Applicants must be in possession of a Senior Certificate/ Matric and completed a Degree or National Diploma/Higher Diploma from a recognised institution of higher learning in the Republic of South Africa in one of the above-mentioned fields of study;
- CV, certified copies of certificates, academic transcript record and identity document must accompany the motivation for the Internship;
- The successful candidates will be appointed for a duration of 12 months **(1) year**, and will be required to sign an Internship Contract.

#### **Application Procedure**
